SHINE for 45 with iReady!

This year our school is using an online curriculum program called iReady. iReady is used in the classroom as a way to enhance the instruction your



child receives from the teacher. iReady is used to diagnose and monitor student strengths and needs. It also provides adaptive instruction based on progress. Our weekly goal for each student is to use iReady for 45 minutes in each subject (reading and math). Time is provided during the week at school, but we also encourage the use at home. As parents, be mindful of the amount of time your students have used iReady during the week. It is recommended that students do not go over 60 minutes of use in each subject.
